SUBJECT: Quarterly Investment Report – June 30, 2021

On April 11, 1996, the Board of Directors adopted Resolution 557 establishing an investment policy for the Santa Maria Public Airport District. Paragraph 12 of that resolution requires the District Manager of Finance and Administration to submit a quarterly investment report to the Board of Directors. This report covers the quarter ending June 30, 2021.

California Government Code Section 53646(e) specifies that if all funds of the District are placed in the Local Agency Investment Fund (LAIF), FDIC-insured accounts and/or in a county investment pool, then the quarterly investment report may consist of copies of the latest statements from such institutions.

The Local Agency Investment Fund (LAIF) is a division of the Pooled Money Investment Account of the State of California (PMIA). Statements of the District's LAIF account activity and the Pooled Money Investment Board Report as of June 30, 2021, are attached and made a part of this quarterly investment report to the District's Board of Directors.

California Government Code Section 53646(b)(1) specifies that the quarterly report shall include the type of investment, issuer, date of maturity, par and dollar amount invested on all securities, investments and moneys held by the local agency, and shall additionally include a description of any of the local agency's funds, investments, or programs, that are under the management of contracted parties, including lending programs. The report shall also include a current market value as of the date of the report and shall include the source of this same valuation. This information is included in the local agency report as of June 30, 2021. SUBLEASE

This Sublease agreement ("Sublease") is made as of 1 August 2021 by and between IES, LLC and VeriJet Holding Company, LLC (VeriJet").

RECITALS

A. IES, LLC (Formerly International Emergency Services, Inc.) is the tenant under the Hangar Space Lease (the "Master Lease") with the SANTA MARIA PUBLIC AIRPORT DISTRICT ("District") as Landlord. IES, LLC leases the aircraft hangar at 3117-C Liberator St, at the Santa Maria Public Airport ("Airport") in Santa Maria, California.

B. VeriJet desires to lease from IES, LLC a 70% portion of the premises to store a Cirrus Vision Jet. IES, LLC is willing to sublease the Premises to VeriJet under the terms, covenants, and conditions stated in the Sublease.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained in the Sublease, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Sublease.** The above recitals are true IES, LLC subleases to VeriJet subject to the terms, covenants, and conditions contained in this Sublease.

2. Term. Month-to-Month Tenancy. Sublease commences on 1 August 2021 and continues on a month-to-month basis (request a 12 month minimum), unless sooner terminated, as provided in the Master Lease or as provided in this section. The Sublease cannot be renewed or extended beyond in accordance with District policy. IES, LLC reserves the right to terminate this Sublease on thirty (30) days written notice to VeriJet. VeriJet will promptly vacate premises upon notice to do so.

3. **Rent.** VeriJet shall pay rent during the term of this Sublease in the amount of \$_____00 per month, payable monthly in advance on the first day of each month. Upon execution of the Sublease, VeriJet will deliver to IES, LLC the first month's rent, plus the amount \$___0____ s a security deposit to be held by IES, LLC under the terms of the Master Lease.

4. **Use.** VeriJet shall use the Subleased Premises in accordance with the provisions of the Master Lease and for no other purpose. VeriJet shall provide the District with a copy of the aircraft registrations of the aircraft to be hangared on the Subleased Premises, within five (5) calendar days of the date of this Sublease, showing ownership by VeriJet. Note: VeriJet already has three (3) aircraft operating in California, more are expected and the tail numbers that are hangered in 3117-C may vary.

5. **Master Lease.** As applied to the Sublease, the words "Landlord," "Tenant" and "Sub Tenant" in the Master Lease will be deemed to refer to District, IES, LLC., and VeriJet, respectively, under this Sublease.

The covenants, agreements, provisions, and conditions of the Master Lease, to the extent that they relate to the Subleased Premises and to the extent that they are not inconsistent with the terms of this Sublease, are made a part of and incorporated into this Sublease.

As between the parties to this Sublease only, in the event of a conflict between the terms of the Master Lease and the terms of the Sublease, the terms of the Master Lease will control.

6. **Notice.** Any notice that may or must be given by either party under this Sublease shall be delivered either personally, or by first class, U.S. mail, postage prepaid. Any notice given to IES, LLC or VeriJet shall be sent to the respective address set forth on the signature page below; or to such other address as that party may designate for service of notice by a written notice given in accordance with the provisions of this section. A notice sent pursuant to the terms of this section shall be deemed delivered as of the time of personal delivery or facsimile, or forty-eight (48) hours after deposit into United States mail as described above.

7. Indemnity. VeriJet shall protect, defend, indemnify and hold IES, LLC and District harmless from and against any and all liabilities, claims, expenses, losses and damages, including reasonable attorneys' fees and costs, that may at any time be asserted against IES, LLC or District by any person as a result of VeriJet's use or occupancy of the Subleased Premises, or VeriJet's presence on the Airport, except to extent that any of the foregoing is caused by the sole active negligence or willful misconduct of IES, LLC or District. The provisions of the section will survive the expiration or earlier termination of the Master Lease or this Sublease.

8. **Insurance.** Aircraft and airport operations insurance, including passengers, products, and completed operations for each aircraft owned or operated by VeriJet on the Airport, or stored on the Premises, with a combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage of \$1,000,000 for each occurrence. District shall be named as an additional insured by VeriJet without offset to any insurance policies of the District. VeriJet shall provide District with copies of all insurance policies and certificates issued by the insurer.

9. Assignment or Subleasing. VeriJet shall not assign this Sublease or sublet all or any portion of the Subleased Premises. Any attempted assignment or sublease shall be void, and, at the option of IES, LLC or District, shall terminate this Sublease.

10. Entire Agreement/Waiver. This Sublease constitutes the final, complete, and exclusive statement between the parties to this Sublease pertaining to the Subleased Premises, supersedes all prior and contemporaneous understandings or agreements of the parties, and is binding on and inures to the benefit of their respective heirs, representatives, successors, and assigns. Any modification or amendment to this Sublease is ineffective, unless that agreement is in writing, is signed by the parties to this Sublease, and specifically states that that agreement modifies this Sublease.

11. **Governing Law.** This Sublease will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California.

12. **Consent of Landlord.** The District's written consent to this Sublease is a condition subsequent to the validity of the Sublease.
