INDEMNITY. In consideration of the issuance of this Use permit, Permittee shall defend (with counsel of District's choosing), indemnify and hold harmless District, its directors, officers, employees, agents and representatives, ("District"), at all times from and against any and all liens, actions, penalties, liabilities, losses, expenses, claims or demands of any nature, including costs and expenses for legal services and causes of action of whatever character which District may incur, sustain or be subjected to (collectively "Liabilities") arising out of or in any way connected with: the acts or omissions of Permittee; or Permittee's operations on, or use of, the airport. Permittee shall also indemnify and hold District harmless from and against any Liabilities including third party claims, environmental requirements and environmental damages, costs or investigation and cleanup, penalties, fines and losses (including, without limitation, diminution in property value of the Airport or District's property or improvements thereon of whatever kind or nature, which result from or are in any way connected with the release, receipt, handling, use, storage, accumulation, transportation, generation, discharge, or disposal ("release, etc.") of any toxic or hazardous materials which occurs, in, on or about the Airport as the result of any of Permittee's activities on the Airport. Permittee shall notify District immediately of any "release, etc." of any toxic or hazardous material on the airport. The foregoing indemnification requires Permittee to indemnify and hold harmless District from and against all Liabilities, excepting only those caused by the sole active negligence or willful misconduct of District.
